Man charged in criminal sex assault grayslake

A 49-year-old Grayslake man is in custody after Grayslake police were alerted by a child welfare worker that he had sexually assaulted a minor.

Police arrested Tim Yeung of 931 Cambridge Drive and charged him with predatory criminal sexual assault, criminal sexual assault and aggravated criminal sexual abuse for incidents in his home between 2001 and 2003.

The 17-year-old victim apparently talked to the caseworker from the Illinois Department of Children and Family Services about the assaults when that person was between 9 and 11-years-old.

Police said Yeung was suicidal Tuesday and police were called to the home where they talked with the caseworker. Yeung works on a production line for a county pharmaceutical company. Police are also questioning the victim's mother.

Police believe no other additional victims exist, but anyone with any information should call detectives at (847) 223-2341. Bond will be set Thursday morning in Lake County Circuit Court.
